Parish Council Report

The Steering Group approved Planet's invoice no. 1146 for consultancy work in tabulating and producing the V&O report.

The Steering Group requests that the Parish Council provides an audit of all transactions to date, relating to the cost of setting up and running the Neighbourhood Plan initiative and that this should include all costs incurred prior to the formation of the Steering Group to manage the process.

Information gathered from local primary schools has been sent to Plan.et for incorporation into the V&O report. Questionnaires from the local Clubs and Organisations are nearing completion. The closing date for responses has been extended to the end of March, when these will be sent to Plan.et.

The response from the residents has been fantastic and we cannot thank them enough for their input.

Looking forward, Plan.et will be engaged in producing our Policies for the Neighbourhood Plan. The Steering Group will input into the direction and content of these Policies and gather evidence to support them where needed.

The Steering Group welcomes the Parish Council's initiative to hold an Open Day for residents to view and comment on the SHELAA. We request that the council shares the responses gathered for inclusion, as evidence, in the Neighbourhood Plan (a mention of this use to be added to the residents' feedback form please).
